

Setting up ABC Codes.

A/B/C code: (1)

The ability exists to code your inventory as being an A/B/C class of item for movement and stocking purposes. The classification is user definable as being a percentage of variance from your target turns in your Purchase Group Master file. There exists the ability to override the variance at the location level, by purchase group. All backorder reports will contain the A/B/C code and you can run reports on demand, or as part of SHUTDOWN, to list the exceptions you are experiencing to the variances. This field is not mandatory, but if an entry is made it must be either an A, B or C.

Set-up

System daily set-up options

Option: ABCINV A/B/C Inventory Actual to Ideal variance

Code "A" inventory percentage variances - Upper: 10 Lower: 10

Code "B" inventory percentage variances - Upper: 10 Lower: 10

Code "C" inventory percentage variances - Upper: 10 Lower: 10

You have an option in Misc. File Maintenance that will plug your inventory according to purchase group. This procedure name is "Plug ABC inventory code, by Purchase Group".
